

The Flash returns tonight with a brand-new status quo, thanks to Barry's decision to save his mother from death at the conclusion of season 2. The third season, based on the "Flashpoint" storyline in the comics, finds Barry in a comfortable life, with both of his parents alive, and plenty of different circumstances for him and his friends. Fans who are familiar with the comic version of Flashpoint know that Barry teamed up with Thomas Wayne's Batman to fix the timeline. While there's no sight of Batman (yet) on the CW, fans wondered if we may see Green Arrow's father, Robert Queen in Thomas' place, especially since the show hinted at Robert also being the Green Arrow of Earth 2 last season. Showrunner Andrew Kreisberg confirmed in an interview with Entertainment Weekly that there are some nods to the comic storyline, but their version of the story will be a lot more personal.
