Sources close to the site have informed them that it's likely two films will be produced at the same time due to the massive savings this ensures the studio. Screenwriter Ehren Kruger reportedly has an well liked idea for the two future installments, but they do NOT include Shia LaBeouf, who's says he's moving on, with other close sources indicating that it'll be Jason Statham who takes over. He will however return as executive producer alongside Steven Spielberg.
