

Star Trek 2 Viacom CEO Philippe Dauman recently offered brief updates on the latest installments in three of Paramount Pictures cash cows, the rebooted Star Trek saga, the Transformers franchise and the Paranormal Activity series. Star Trek 2 is finally starting to pick up and get itself together, following a year of slow developments. Work on the fourth installments of the Transformers Franchise and the Paranormal Activity Franchise has (reportedly) begun, but both are all-but-guaranteed to come to fruition eventually. Dauman told THR that previous reports about director/producer J.J. Abrams being committed to Star Trek 2 were indeed correct— and that the filmmaker is currently focused on developing the next installment in the science fiction franchise. However, those who were still holding out hopes that the Star Trek sequel —which may feature Benicio Del Toro as its mystery villain— could pull a First Class and get it's self together for a late 2012
