

James Wan's standalone Aquaman flick was originally set to swim into theaters on July 27, 2018, but Warner Bros. has now announced that it'll actually open almost 3 months later than that on October 5. We still don't know a whole lot about this first solo outing for the King of Atlantis, but it will also see Amber Heard and Willem Dafoe reprise their Justice League roles as Mera and Vulko, respectively. Wan has been posting the occasional location scouting pic to Instagram, however, and this latest one is widely believed to be doubling for Amnesty Bay - the small coastal town that was home to Aquaman's (Jason Momoa) adoptive father, Tom Curry.
