

As a result of the tragic events in Aurora, Colorado, on Thursday night, the screening of The Dark Knight Rises on Saturday for members of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts & Sciences was a fairly sombre affair with The Hollywood Reporter revealing that those in attendance apparently left, "quickly and without much discussion." Academy President Tom Sherak tells the site, "We knew we were going to have a huge crowd even before the tragedy; a lot of people had been talking about coming. Even I, who normally would not come to this side of town to go to a movie, was planning on coming before the tragedy because it felt like a big summer movie and I wanted to see it.
