

Ever since Joss Whedon was announced as the director of The Avengers, fans have put Nathan Fillion forward for several different roles in the Marvel Cinematic Universe in order to re-team the duo after they worked on the likes of Firefly, Serenity and Dr. Horrible's Sing-Along Blog.
