

X-Men: First Class is top of the list for errors over at Movie Mistakes, and while some of these are a little petty (the continuity errors for example, when this movie is believed to only be very loosely linked to Bryan Singer's X-Men and X-2 rather than The Last Stand and X-Men Origins: Wolverine) most are pretty bad mistakes! Personally, I only noticed a couple of these, none of which ruined the movie for me or took me out of the moment. Visible crew/equipment: In the scene where Sebastian Shaw is revealing the Magneto helmet to Emma Frost in the submarine, you can see the microphone in the helmet's reflection through the entire scene. Factual error: When the US & Soviet navies attack the mutants on the beach they fire a large volley of surface to surface missiles.
